



## NOTICE OF CANCELATIONS

RE: Cancellation of Public Performances and Events

By order of Mayor London N. Breed, to prevent the spread of COVID-19, all public performances, events and gatherings at the San Francisco War Memorial & Performing Arts Center are hereby canceled from Saturday, 3/7/20, through Friday, 3/20/20.

This is an important step to protect public health.

As of today, the aforementioned types of gatherings may resume beginning Saturday, 3/21/20. That date is subject to change based on further directives from the Office of the Mayor.

Based on this order, and under direction of Thomas E. Horn, President of the War Memorial Board of Trustees, I am hereby canceling all public performances, events and gatherings from Saturday, 3/7/20, through Friday, 3/20/20.

This cancellation includes all uses of the War Memorial Opera House, Davies Symphony Hall, Herbst Theatre, The Green Room, Taube Atrium Theatre, Bryan Education Studio, and Veterans Meeting Rooms.

This cancellation does not affect use of office space, rehearsals or crew calls without public attendance, Café Valor, the San Francisco Arts Commission Gallery, or the Veterans Gallery.

This is an evolving situation, and more information will be made available in the coming days.
