Dear Trustees of the War Memorial Board.

San Francisco Opera requests permission to increase the Facility Fees currently charged to Opera patrons. Current fees are \$1 per ticket in the Balcony and \$2 per ticket in all other seating sections. The new prices would be \$2 per ticket in the Balcony and \$3 per ticket in all other seating sections.

As we work with the Ballet and the War Memorial on various projects to enhance patron experience in the Opera House, we continue to receive complaints about the comfort and condition of the auditorium seats. Response to the first phase of the project, installation of new seats in the Balcony, was enthusiastic; patrons are constantly asking when the next phases will be completed.

At the moment further phases are limited by a lack of accrued funding. Because the Ballet has more performances in a year than the Opera (given *Nutcracker*), the Opera proposes to increase just the Opera fee to better equalize the money being collected by both organizations. The Ballet has indicated that they have no concerns with there being two different fees between organizations, and neither does the Opera. During the initial fee implementation, neither company received complaints or comments when the fee was introduced. Both note the fee in appropriate collateral.

We ask for this fee increase, likely effective with single tickets in the Opera's summer 2017 season and all but Ring tickets for the 2017-18 season, to ensure that the availability of funds will not hold up the next phase.

San Francisco Ballet \$1,478,730

Total Expenses to date \$ 975.762

Balance at end of FY17 (projected) \$1,445,405
