#### RESOLUTION NO. 18-13

RESOLVED, By the Board of Trustees of the War Memorial of San Francisco that Purchase Order Nos. PO151023 through PO153984 are hereby approved.

Ms. Norris reminded Trustees that they must file their annual FPPC Statement of Economic Interest Form 700 as well as complete the Ethics and Sunshine Ordinance trainings by April 2, 2018.

## **REGULAR ITEMS**

<u>Patina Restaurant Group – Opera House North Box Bar service format</u>: President Bechtle stated that Trustees have received a letter from the Patina Restaurant Group requesting to change the service format and hours for the Opera House North Box Bar and Lobby.

Brian Crowell, Patina General Manager at the War Memorial, stated that Patina would like to implement the following on a trial basis:

- Change the hours for the Opera House North Box Bar and Lobby to match those of lower lounge Café at the Opera, open 2 hours pre-performance and all intermissions
- Create a menu that is unique to the space featuring tapas and small plate options
- Improve the reservations system, moving to the Open Table, the same web-based format used for Café at the Opera.

Following discussion and on motion of Trustee Horn, seconded by Vice President Walker, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

## RESOLUTION NO. 18-14

RESOLVED, By the Board of Trustees of the War Memorial of San Francisco that it hereby approves the request of the Patina Restaurant Group to change the service format and hours for the Opera House North Box Bar and Lobby.

Symphony request to install season ticket renewal campaign graphics: President Bechtle stated that Trustees have received a letter from the San Francisco Symphony requesting to install 2018-19 season ticket renewal campaign graphics in Davies Symphony Hall from mid-March through June 30, 2018. Following discussion and on motion of Trustee Wilsey, seconded by Vice President Walker, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

### RESOLUTION NO. 18-15

RESOLVED, By the Board of Trustees of the War Memorial of San Francisco that it hereby approves the request of the San Francisco Symphony to install 2018-19 season ticket renewal campaign graphics in Davies Symphony Hall from mid-March through June 30, 2018.

Trustee Horn said that today Thursday, March 8, is International Women's Day.
