Description of Public Purposes of the War Memorial:

- a. Furthering the charitable purposes of the War Memorial under the War Memorial Trust Agreement and the San Francisco Charter.
- b. Facilitating the performance of a ceremonial role or function by a City Official on behalf of the City at an event.
- Facilitating public officials' familiarity with, or ability to carry out their services or fiduciary duties with respect to the management, administration, and/or C. care of the War Memorial.
- d. Monitoring and evaluation of operation and maintenance of public facilities available for City resident and visitor use by City employees.
- Promotion of economic development and employment in the City and surrounding areas. e.
- f. Promotion of City tourism on a local, state, national, or worldwide scale.
- Promotion of intergovernmental relations and/or cooperation and coordination of resources with other governmental agencies, including, but not limited g. to, attendance at an event with or by elected officials, appointed public officials, or dignitaries from other jurisdictions, and their immediate family members or no more than one guest, solely for their personal use.
- Promotion of cultural exchange amongst other artistic and cultural organizations, including, but not limited to, attendance at an event with or by h. organization officials, staff, and guests.
- Promoting, supporting and/or showing appreciation for programs or services rendered by charitable, non-profit, or educational organizations benefitting San Francisco residents.
- Facilitating increased direct contact, input from, and communication with, tenants, licensees, and event representatives.
- Facilitating familiarity of War Memorial staff and employees with the function of the venues during use by the public so they may better carry out their k. duties with respect to the maintenance, administration, and/or care of the War Memorial.
- I. Furthering any other public purpose that a department or commission is required or authorized by law to pursue.
